

Latest Firmware for HQR1 and HQR2 Digital video recorders

The update contained in **UPDATE.ZIP** contains both firmware for the HQR1 and HQR2 digital video recorders as well as an updated PC software application.

How to install Software

Unzip the files in to a folder on your computer.

Uninstall the DCS-HQR software from your computer.

Install the latest version of the DCS-HQR software by double clicking the "setup" file.

Reboot the computer.

How to install firmware

Copy the two files called image.2510.img and osd.img to a blank CF card.

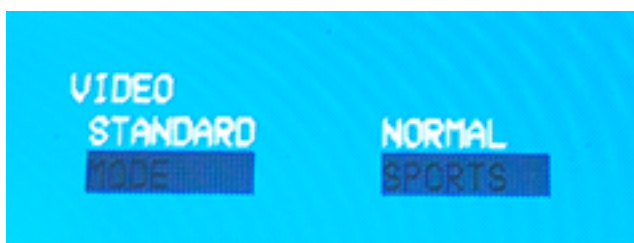
Insert the card in to the HQR recorder and turn the unit on by connecting to the mains power supply.

Let the update take place, it should take about 2 minutes.

The HQR will reboot and the firmware will have been updated.

Changes to the firmware and menu system

SPORTS MODE



This latest firmware update adds "Sports Mode" encoding.

It is highly recommended to use this mode when recording high motion video.

Video quality will be drastically increased using "Sports Mode" in either Mpeg2 or Mpeg4 mode.

For the highest quality video: Use "Sports Mode" in Mpeg2 format.

"Sports Mode" can be enabled in the "VIDEO" menu on the HQR Recorder.

PowerREC

PowerREC allows you to automatically start recording on power up. When the power is cut to the DC input the unit will save the video file and shut down.

To enable PowerREC: Navigate to the "Record" menu and enable both "PowerREC" and "AutoREC"

Go to the "System" menu and enable "PowerOff"
